

Cllr. Mary Rose Desmond Notice of Motion (1):

"In respect of the recently announced Carr's Hill Interchange proposal, that Cork County Council calls on Transport Infrastructure Ireland (TII) to hold a town hall style public meeting in addition to the public briefing they have planned. This is necessary to allow residents and commuters affected by the M28 proposal a fair opportunity to voice their concerns. Also that Cork County Council seek an extension of the TII's initial feedback submission deadline of the 20th November next."

Response from National Roads Office:

Cork County Council and TII will not be holding town hall style public meeting on the proposals at Carr's Hill in addition to the public briefing held on 9th November 2015. A public consultation will be held in Quarter 1 2016 which will give the elected members and members of the public further opportunity to voice their concerns. The feedback submission deadline has been extended to 30th November 2015.
